

# ONE YEAR ADVENTURE WITH GOD

## October 2014-November 2015



Dear faithful prayer partners and financial supporters

Many things have been done in the village of Tamani where we relocate the church; the first of them was the construction of a temporary shelter to serve as place of worship.

December 20 was the first graduation at Faculté Baptiste de Théologies where Koffi teaches.

On December 24 and 25 we celebrated Christmas in Tamani to begin our church activities there with a film projection.

In February 2015 we showed on big screen the final game of the Africa Nations Soccer cup and at the occasion, we sow the seeds by preaching the gospel. 10 teenagers and one adult trusted Christ as Lord and Savior.

In March, 2015, the Land became the church's property as we signed the deeds of sale at the Notary lawyer's office.

On July 18 and 20 we had our ladies outreach program which was training in knitting, liquid soap making and cooking. This was a successful event. 20 ladies and girls participated and salvation decisions were made following the training, as three of the ladies came to church the following Sundays. This experience revived in Elizabeth the desire to create a training center called "Tabita Center"

On August 5-7, we had VBS 2015. More than 130 children came and many salvation decisions made. The theme was the life of Daniel. Sunday august 9 was children's day. The children were in charge of the whole service under Koffi's supervision and one of the boys preached to the congregation. Two weeks after VBS, we organized a soccer tournament over three weeks period during which we preach the Gospel. At the end of the games, we distributed school supplies to all the 64 boys of the 8 teams who participated.

Following the soccer tournament, a door was opened for Koffi to preach to a soccer club who rehearsed on Sunday morning near our church. 7 of them gave their lives to Jesus and 12 bibles were distributed to the players who needed one. Each Sunday morning, Koffi spent 15 minutes preaching to the soccer players between Sunday school and worship service.

At the beginning of the month of September we went to Kpalimé and surveyed three villages with the intention to plant a new church there. After much prayer, we felt that the Lord was leading us to start a new church in Agou about 2 hours North West of Lomé. We have given the responsibility of door to door evangelism to one of Koffi's Bible student who is also a high school teacher there, to be in charge of the outreach. People are getting saved. And a discipleship program has started.

On October 9-10, we had an evangelistic campaign with movies and gospel preaching. The result was a high attendance and a lady was saved and has started baptism class. Our Baptism class has 9 disciples.

On November 12-14, we had our first Bible Conference in Town and about 80 pastors, deacons and Sunday school teachers participated and each one received a certificate. The speaker was

IGM's missionary to India Stephen Schaefer. The theme of the conference was: Jesus, our Prophet, Priest and King.

For the next two years, our **goal** is to plant a church in Agou, to start evangelizing another village west side of Lomé, to continue building the church in Tamani and to get a 15 passage van for our bus ministry.(\$6,000.00)

We praise the Lord and we give Him glory for his leading in our lives and ministry

Church attendance now is around 85 people including the children.
